Your branch may allow you to file a consent so that the branch can help others, such as relatives, get in touch with you directly, or so that the branch may act as your agent by providing selected information on your behalf.

The Association Council allows scholars and institutions access to other personal contact information for academic purposes, and approves each request individually.

An open-access website to interest potential new members has been proposed but with access to only archival information current to the same historical dates used by The Ontario Archives (births up to 97 years ago, marriages 82 years and deaths 72 years). **Your permission will allow the Association the ability to further this aim.**
