

Chapter 7. MOORES VS MOORE. WHAT'S IN A NAME?

If one adds back into the month the 11 days that actually occurred but were "discarded" with the making of a newer calendar in 1752, then Reverend Joseph W Dally's recording of a true birth date of November 15th, 1738 (New Style) for an individual whose name was **John Moores**, becomes, hypothetically, November 4th, 1738 (Old Style).
