

## Threads in the Tapestry of Canada: Some Loyalist Descendants Buried in Beechwood Cemetery

The Sir Guy Carleton Branch, UELAC, announces the sale of a new book, “Threads in the Tapestry of Canada: Some Loyalist Descendants Buried in Beechwood Cemetery.” The book highlights the lives of eighteen United Empire Loyalist descendants buried in Beechwood, Canada’s National Cemetery in Ottawa, and their Loyalist ancestors. These Loyalist descendants have enriched and enhanced the lives of their fellow citizens and contributed to the success and vibrancy of Ottawa and of Canada. The stories of their ancestors demonstrate the difficulties and suffering overcome in order to create a peaceful life in a new land under the British Crown.

The author, Branch member Dorothy Meyerhof, is the descendant of three Loyalist ancestors for whom she has received UELAC certificates. The origin of this book was a [guided tour of Beechwood Cemetery](#) on 14 September 2014, organized by the Sir Guy Carleton Branch to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of the UELAC. This 97-page, coil-bound book includes more complete stories of the descendants and their Loyalist ancestors than could be included in the tour booklet, as well as extensive references to original sources. It contains pictures, where available, of the descendants, their Loyalist ancestors and of the grave stones, along with the location of the graves in Beechwood Cemetery.
