

Loyalist Quilt from Costume Branch



This lovely Loyalist Quilt was created by the Costume Branch sometime before they dissolved in 2005. It features six rings of roses alternating with white scalloped rings separated by bands creating red borders. Beautifully hand-quilted on cotton, it is an heirloom the winner will treasure. The Costume Branch arose from a committee dedicated to supplying patterns and suggestions for costumes. The branch was begun in 1988 in Toronto while Dr. Vera Vanderlip UE was Dominion President.

A proposal has been suggested by Daryl Currie UE that this quilt be used to raise funds for our UELAC Branches. Each Branch across Canada would sell tickets on this quilt to their own members. At the next UELAC Conference a draw would take place and a winner announced. Each Branch would keep the funds they raised, making us all winners and giving the quilt a worthy home.
