Winter has arrived; this is a good time to look back on our Branch different activities in 2024

Branch Reports

Activities Report:

- Our Branch was the sponsor of the 2024 Marion L. Phelps Lecture Series, a series of six lectures held by the Brome County Historical Society in January and February and given by historian Jimmy Manson. It was a success and as agreed Jimmy had as subject "The Loyalists" for one of the lectures. Our Branch will again be the sponsor for the 2025 Marion L. Phelps Lecture Series.
- On June 6, 7 and 8, 2024, branch member Michel Racicot and second-branch member Holly Haimerl participated at the 2024 UELAC Conference held in Cornwall, Ontario.
- The 55th Annual General Meeting and Luncheon was held on Saturday, June 12, 2024, at the Odd Fellows' Lodge in Knowlton, QC. Twenty-six members and guests were present for the luncheon which started at 12:15 p.m. followed by the Annual General Meeting.
- Reprint of the book "The Loyalists of Quebec-1774-1825-A Forgotten History" first published in 1989 by Heritage Branch-Montreal. 300 copies of the book were reprinted and so far, more than 175 copies have been distributed to members, historical societies, libraries, etc. A few bookstores have the book on sale. In 2023, our Branch had reprinted 500 copies of the third edition of the book "Loyalist of the Eastern Townships" first published by our Branch in 1984 and reprinted in 1992. More than 300 copies have already been distributed. Branch member Ross Gledhill took charge of both projects by making the necessary arrangements with the printer and the distribution of both books.
- Branch members Arlene Royea and Ross Gledhill represented the Branch at the Townshippers' Festival that took place on Saturday, September 21, 2024, at the Brome County Fairgrounds from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- On Saturday, October26, 2024, at the Odd Fellows' Lodge in Knowlton, QC, twenty-six members and friends participated at our Fall Luncheon. Our guest speaker was Heather Darch UE, project manager of the Quebec Anglophone Heritage Network (QAHN) and retired curator of the Missisquoi Museum. Heather gave us with a very interesting PowerPoint presentation based on her years of research on St. Armand's Black Community, presentation titled "In the Shadow of the Rock Finding the Black Community of Missisquoi Bay".
